## Dress Code Policy

Our dress code is designed to create a climate where learners are more concerned with academic achievement than what they or their peers are wearing.

### When our student should be In dress code:

All students should be in dress code daily, beginning on the first day of class.

The teacher will make contact with the parents if a student is out of dress code. **We must be consistent.**

From that point forward all students not in dress code will be sent to the office to call someone to bring him/her the proper clothes. Special days will be designated for Out-of-Dress-Code days. On these days, the clothes worn should be appropriate for the school environment.

### Other Information:

\* No apparel, dress, or grooming that is or may become disruptive to the classroom atmosphere or educational process can be permitted.

- All shorts, skirts and jumpers are 2 or 3 inches above the knee.
- No sandals, flip-flops, hi-heels, cowboy boots.
- Socks required with all shoe types.
- No logo's allowed on shirts or pants.

Girls may wear white or blue shorts under jumpers and skirts.

- No body piercing, except for the post earrings.
- Hats are not permitted.
- Colored hair (such as blue, purple, pink, etc) is not allowed.

### Allowed Dress Code Colors;

Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Jumpers

**Shirts (Polo with collar)**

Turtle Neck Shirts

Sweaters/Vests

Navy Blue and Khaki

Any solid color allowed (no stripes or prints)

Any solid color allowed (no stripes or prints)

Solid navy blue, solid white, solid yellow, solid light blue

Sweatshirts (**NO HOODS**)

Any solid color allowed (no stripes or prints)

**ONLY SCHOOL LOGOS ON SHIRTS, SWEATERS OR SWEATSHIRTS**

Belts must be worn with pants that have loops.

Absolutely NO opened-toed shoes for students at any time!

Shirts will be tucked in at all times.
